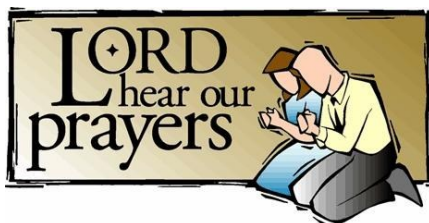

**GRANT OPPORTUNITY** Do you have experience in grant writing? Shepherd has an amazing opportunity to apply for a grant through the Lutheran Church Extension Fund (LCEF). The Kaleidoscope Fund, a granting program established by LCEF, helps ministries shine brightly and share the Gospel. In the last two years, the fund has granted over \$1.2 million to 22 different Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod ministries that are related to the expansion, enrichment and energizing of Christ's Church. These grants help strengthen congregations, Lutheran schools, church workers and the communities they impact.

- Funds will be granted in amounts between \$25,000 to \$250,000.
- The process will now begin with a grant proposal summary.
- The committee will then select ministries from these proposals to apply for a grant.
