Missionary of the Month

Each month, Shepherd of the Hills Mission Ministry designates a missionary that the congregation supports. In February, we focus on **Reverend Tim Norton** in Navajo, New Mexico,

Pastor Tim Norton, his wife Heidi, and their two children Philip and Leslie serve the Navajo people in New Mexico at Shepherd of the Valley, Navajo, NM. The area of the Navajo Nation is 25,000 square miles and is the "largest Native nation."



Lutheran Indian Ministries and the Nortons' long-term goal for the Navajo people is "to train Navajo leaders who can plant churches and demonstrate Christ's love to their own people, in their own communities, across the expansive Navajo Nation." Since arriving at Navajo, Pastor Tim has become an ordained pastor, has learned some Navajo language and has sought to learn their culture. He has officiated at several baptisms and confirmations. Heidi provides Bible studies for the women, some of whom have suffered from abuse in various ways.

Pray for the Nortons in their ministry and for the Navajo people that they may find the peace of love of Jesus in this Holy Word.
